**RENAMING THE URDANETA CITY BYPASS ROAD IN THE CITY OF  
URDANETA, PANGASINAN TO EDUARDO COJUANGCO, JR. AVENUE**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The leadership of Eduardo Cojuangco, Jr. is impeccable. Though he had been associated with the biggest food conglomerate in the country, San Miguel Corporation, with diverse enterprises and known beyond our borders, he had never forgotten the small ones, in his company, in his country. His love for his co-workers and countrymen in the time of the COVID-19 pandemic, inspired the kind of caring response that San Miguel Corporation has implemented to alleviate the plight of our people.

The Urdaneta City bypass road has started from the vision to establish an improved national road system in the Province of Pangasinan. In view of the foregoing, the approval of this measure is earnestly sought.



AN ACT  
RENAMING THE URDANETA CITY BYPASS ROAD IN THE CITY OF  
URDANETA, PANGASINAN TO EDUARDO COJUANGCO, JR. AVENUE

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines  
in Congress assembled:*

1           **SECTION 1.** *Renaming of Urdaneta City Bypass Road.*- The name of  
2 Urdaneta City Bypass Road located in the City of Urdaneta, Pangasinan is hereby  
3 changed to Eduardo Cojuanco, Jr. Avenue.

4           **SECTION 2.** *Effectivity.* - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after  
5 its complete publication in at least two newspapers of general publication.
