RESOLUTION AMENDING RULE IV, SECTION 6 AND RULE X, SECTIONS 13 AND 18 OF THE RULES OF THE SENATE

RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, To amend, as it hereby amends, Rule IV, Section 6 and Rule X, Sections 13 and 18 of the Rules of the Senate to read as follows:

1	"RULE IV
2	THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE,
3	HIS DUTIES AND POWERS
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6	"SEC. 6. In case of the temporary absence of the President or the
7	President Pro Tempore, the Majority Leader or in his absence, ANY OF THE
8	TWO [Assistant] DEPUTY Majority LeaderS, or any member designated by
9	the President shall discharge the powers and duties of the President.

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13	"RULE X
14	THE COMMITTEES
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16	"SEC. 13. After the organization of the Senate in the manner provided
17	in Rule IX, the following permanent committees shall be formed, with the
18	duties, powers and general jurisdiction specified hereunder:
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- 1) Committee on Rules. Nine (9) members. All matters affecting the Rules of the Senate; the calendar as well as parliamentary rules and the order and manner of transacting business and the creation of committees. The [Chairman] CHAIRPERSON of the Committee shall be the Majority Leader of the Senate[.] AND [T]the TWO Vice [Chairmen] CHAIRPERSONS shall be the [Assistant] DEPUTY Majority Leaders.
- 2) Accountability of Public Officers and Investigations. xxx

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- 3) *Accounts.* [Eleven (11)] **THIRTEEN (13)** members. All matters relating to the auditing and adjustment of all accounts chargeable against the funds for the expenses and activities of the Senate.
- 4) Agriculture, Food and Agrarian Reform. [Fifteen (15)] **SEVENTEEN (17)** members. All matters relating to agriculture, food production and agribusiness, including agricultural experimental stations, agricultural economics and research; soil survey and conservation; agricultural education; technical extension services; animal husbandry; livestock quarantine; agricultural support price; and fisheries and aquatic resources; and all matters relating to agrarian reform, landed estates, and implementation of the agrarian land reform provisions of the Constitution.
- 5) ARTS AND CULTURE. NINE (9) MEMBERS. ALL MATTERS RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF MUSEUMS, SHRINES, MONUMENTS, AND OTHER HISTORICAL SITES AND EDIFICES; INITIATIVES IN FOSTERING ARTISTIC PRACTICES INNOVATIONS IN A RANGE OF PLATFORMS FOR PRESENTATION; SUPPORT FOR SCHOLARSHIP, CURATORSHIP AND DISSEMINATION OF KNOWLEDGE IN ARTS AND CULTURE; TRAINING PROGRAMS AND CULTURAL AND ARTISTIC PROGRAMS INTERNATIONAL **INSTITUTIONS AND ORGANIZATIONS** OF OPERATING IN THE PHILIPPINES, SUCH AS THE UNESCO; AND THE PRESERVATION, ENRICHMENT AND EVOLUTION OF FILIPINO ARTS CULTURE, **BUILT AND INTANGIBLE, AND** IN BOTH TRADITIONAL AND CONTEMPORARY FORMS.
- [5] **6)** Banks, Financial Institutions and Currencies. [Nine (9)] **ELEVEN (11)** members. All matters relating to banks, financial institutions, government and private currencies, capital markets, mutual funds, securitization, coinage and circulation of money.

[6] 7) Basic Education [,Arts and Culture]. — Fifteen (15) members. All matters directly and principally relating to early childhood care and education, preschool, kindergarten, [primary] ELEMENTARY and secondary education, science high schools except the Philippine Science High School System, SPORTS HIGH SCHOOLS, teachers and students welfare, teacher education and competency, non-formal, informal, indigenous learning systems, special NEEDS education and community adult education; inclusive education, scholarships, grants, subsidies and incentives to deserving students; the national language; and the establishment and maintenance of libraries. [museums, shrines, monuments, and other historical sites and edifices; training programs and cultural and artistic programs of international institutions and organizations operating in the Philippines, such as the UNESCO; and the preservation, enrichment and evolution of Filipino arts and culture].

[7] 8) Civil Service, Government Reorganization and Professional Regulation.

- [Seven (7)] NINE (9) members. All matters relating to the Civil Service and the status of officers and employees of the government including their appointment, discipline, retirement; their compensation privileges, benefits and incentives; implementation of the constitutional provisions on the rights of government workers to form and join labor organizations; public sector labor-management relations and collective negotiation agreements; the regulation of and admission to and the practice of the professions; and reorganization of the government or any of its branches or instrumentalities; all human resource development programs pertaining to the Government; and all other matters relating to the bureaucracy.

- [8] **9)** Constitutional Amendments and Revision of Codes. [Eleven (11)] **THIRTEEN (13)** members. All matters proposing amendments to the Constitution of the Philippines and the revision of the existing codes.
- [9] **10)** Cooperatives. [Nine (9)] **ELEVEN (11)** members. All matters relating to cooperatives, both urban and rural based, including but not limited to farm credit and farm security, cooperative movements, marketing and consumers' organizations; and the implementation of the Cooperative Code of the Philippines.
- [10] **11**) Cultural Communities **AND MUSLIM AFFAIRS**. [Seven (7)] **NINE (9)** members. All matters relating to cultural communities **AND**

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SEC. 18. The membership of the permanent committees, including their respective [Chairmen] CHAIRPERSONS, shall be chosen by the Senate. THE DEPUTY MAJORITY LEADERS AND DEPUTY MINORITY LEADER SHALL BE MEMBERS OF ALL PERMANENT COMMITTEES. The [Chairman] CHAIRPERSON of each committee may designate the Vice [Chairman] CHAIRPERSON or such Vice [Chairmen] CHAIRPERSONS of [his] THE committee and create such subcommittees as may be deemed necessary.
