

RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE POWERLIFTING ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR THEIR SUCCESSFUL CAMPAIGN REPRESENTING OUR COUNTRY IN THE 2022 SOUTHEAST ASIAN CUP

WHEREAS, Art. XIV, Section 19 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that "the State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry;"

WHEREAS, it is in recognition of this policy that we recognize and honor the significant achievements of our countrymen in the field of sports to encourage and incentivize excellence among our athletes;

WHEREAS, the Powerlifting Association of the Philippines represented our nation in the 2022 Southeast Asian Cup held in Johor Baru, Malaysia, competing in both Men's and Women's divisions, dominating the competition;

WHEREAS, our athletes gave an absolutely exemplary performance, all the effort and hard work in preparation for the cup paid off, in both divisions we bested our opponents, even setting new records;

WHEREAS, our Men's Team won a total of 49 medals, completely dominating their competition in the Men's division, winning the Philippines 23 gold medals, 13 silver medals and 13 bronze medals and setting 3 new Asian records;

WHEREAS, our Women's Team also gave a similar performance, finishing strong and bagging a total of 29 medals, 21 of which are gold, 4 are silver and 4 are bronze, while also setting 7 new Asian records;
