RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING THE AWARDEES OF METROBANK FOUNDATION OUTSTANDING FILIPINOS OF 2025

WHEREAS, the Metrobank Foundation, the corporate social responsibility arm of the Metrobank Group, is committed to promote a culture of excellence in the academe, military, and police sectors through the Metrobank Foundation Outstanding Filipinos with its component searches, namely: [a] Award for Teachers, [b] Award for Soldiers, and [c] Award for Police Officers;

5	distinguished members of the Preliminary and Final Board of Judges selected four (4)

8	WHEREAS, for 40 years now since the program was first started in 1985, a total				
9	of seven hundred twenty-five (725) outstanding Filipino exemplars have been
