RESOLUTION
HONORING AND COMMENDING THE AWARDEES OF METROBANK
FOUNDATION OUTSTANDING FILIPINOS OF 2025

1 WHEREAS, the Metrobank Foundation, the corporate social responsibility arm
2 of the Metrobank Group, is committed to promote a culture of excellence in the
3 academe, military, and police sectors through the Metrobank Foundation Outstanding
4 Filipinos with its component searches, namely: [a] Award for Teachers, [b] Award for
5 Soldiers, and [c] Award for Police Officers;

6 WHEREAS, the Metrobank Foundation Outstanding Filipinos is a career-service
7 award that honors Filipino teachers, soldiers, and police officers who personify the
8 ideal brand of public service, one that is grounded on the values of patriotism,
9 integrity, courage, and social responsibility, and is being implemented by the
10 Metrobank Foundation in partnership with Department of Education, Commission on
11 Higher Education, Armed Forces of the Philippines, Philippine National Police,
12 Philippine Savings Bank, Rotary Club of Makati Metro, and Rotary Club of New Manila
13 East;

14 WHEREAS, the Metrobank Foundation Outstanding Filipinos are citizens who
15 model excellence in their profession and who go above and beyond the call of service;

1 WHEREAS, with the theme "Beyond Excellence", the 40th cycle of the program
2 was launched last 6 December 2024 with the objective of recognizing ten (10)
3 exemplary Filipinos for their outstanding services and contributions to nation-building;

4 WHEREAS, after a dynamic, exhaustive, and year-long selection process, the
5 distinguished members of the Preliminary and Final Board of Judges selected four (4)
6 teachers, three (3) soldiers, and three (3) police officers as the 2025 Metrobank
7 Foundation Outstanding Filipinos;

8 WHEREAS, for 40 years now since the program was first started in 1985, a total
9 of seven hundred twenty-five (725) outstanding Filipino exemplars have been
10 recognized by the Metrobank Foundation, consisting of 388 teachers, 175 soldiers,
